Dear Friends,

As this year draws to a close, I want to thank each of you for supporting The Bridge Home No Kill Animal Rescue. Each of you has supported us in one way another. Whether you have adopted; donated money, volunteer time, or supplies; shared our posts on Facebook; or followed us and given moral support to our animals, you are making a difference in these animals' lives. We truly appreciate all of your efforts. It is because of YOU that we can continue our work to care for homeless animals until their new family comes to give them a furever home. I am proud of our Rescue and our work to re-home 289 animals to date in 2023. I am reminded daily that it is people like YOU that help to make all of this possible. We are grateful to all of you for helping to give cats and dogs a second chance for a loving home.

We are looking ahead to 2024 with a number of ambitious projects that will help the animals live more comfortably and safely at our facility. We must replace the non-operational HVAC system so we have reliable heat and air in animal areas. We must also replace the guillotine doors that allow dogs safe access to their outdoor kennels from inside. Lastly, we are applying new flooring in the cat adoption room and reception area that will be more durable, sanitary, and easy to clean.

These projects represent substantial investments of funds and total approximately \$90,000 dollars to complete. We are asking for your help this holiday season for the animals and these projects. Please consider participating in our Season of Giving Program, which also includes the Pet Angel Trees and the Trim a Tree programs which are detailed below.

We greatly appreciate the support of our community, as we rely solely on donations. One hundred percent of your gift goes to taking care of our homeless pets while they wait for their new family.

Thank you for your support! On behalf of all the staff, volunteers, and the Board of Directors, we wish you happy holidays and good health in the New Year.




Warm Our Paws and Our Hearts Fundraising Campaign (through December 31)
